The award is to be given to an outstanding and presently employed as a scientific worker of Assam of the age group of 35 to 45 years as an additional incentive and stimulus to pursue advanced level research in the field of Plant sciences. The Award will be given away in collaboration with Dr Ananta Bora Memorial Trust.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE AWARD:

1. The Award will carry an amount of Rs. 10000.00(Ten thousand) and a citation.
2. a) The Award will be given away in the Annual conference of the Society.
b) The Awardee will be invited to deliver the Award lecture at a venue and time to be decided by the Society
3. The Award is open to any scientific worker of Plant Sciences from Assam doing outstanding works in Assam/NEIndia.
4. Outstanding original research contribution in plant sciences preceding 5 (Five) years of the year of the Award to be decided on the basis of publication, patents, reports and papers presented in learned Societies / journals and/or their impact on the particular field will be the criteria for this award.
5. Application/Nomination for the award is to be submitted to the President of Botanical Society of Assam by the applicant him or herself /Head of the Institution/Department/organisation/Fellow BSA.
6. A screening committee will be constituted by the President of the Society in consultation with the executive committee for the purpose of screening and processing all the applications/nominations for the award.
7. Apanel of judges will select the candidate eligible for the award. The judges will be selected from a panel of eminent Botanist approved by a committee consisting of not more than five members constituted by the Executive Committee of the Society.
8. If there is no suitable candidate for the Award according to the opinion of the panel of experts/judges, the award for the year will not be conferred.
